- 1) (a) a woman who has never had relations; (b) widow; (c) one whose *בְּתוּלָה* status has been altered due to injury
- 2) When one makes a statement which is not as advantageous as another statement which he could have made, he is believed.
- 3) One who wants to take something from someone else must prove that he is entitled to it
- 4) If one says something which enters himself into a state of being *חַיִּיב* and then goes on to say something which exempts him, he's believed. E.g. "this field belonged to your father, but I bought it from him"
- 5) He is *חַיִּיב מֵיִתָּה* and only gets the more severe punishment
- 6) One who confesses to owing a fine is exempt
- 7) What one's wife earns or makes
- 8) 12 months
- 9) 1500, since he can make a profit from the 1000 *זוּז*
- 10) The customs of Jewish women and how they behave
- 11) The right for one who is owed money to collect his payment from the debtor's property if he can't pay back with money.
- 12) The dowry & *כְּתוּבָה* of a woman which *מִדְּרַבָּנָן* is inherited by her children
- 13) Splitting the actual *כְּתוּבָה מִדְּאוּרֵיִתָּא* and the *כְּתוּבַת בְּנֵי דְכָרִין*
- 14) 2 things said by *בֶּן אֲבִישָׁלוֹם* and 7 things said by *אֲדָמוֹן*
- 15) 1 opinion says that this shows that he's lying, but the other opinion says that he could claim that he only did it because it's easier for him to take the field back from *שְׂמַעוֹן* than from *לוי*
