

Rules:

- קפַּק אְפֵּיקא - In a case where there are 2 doubtful/possible reasons to be lenient, we are lenient

בְּרָכּוֹת לְהָקֵל - In a doubtful case one doesn't make a בְּרְכּוֹת לְהָקֵל - One doesn't sin for no benefit
- סוב מידי מידי מִצְשֵּׁר - a non-Jew who owns land in אָרֶץ יִשְּׂרְאֵל לְהַפְּקִיעַ מִידִי מַצְשֵּׂר - a non-Jew who owns land in מַצְשְׂרוֹת is not considered the owner to remove the obligation of מַצְשְׂרוֹת - When the status of something will only later be defined, but when it is then it's considered to always have had that status, retroactively - הַּבֶּה שַׁאָסַר הוּא הַבֶּה שְׁהָתִּיר - If one makes a statement that forbids/obligates something and subsequently makes a statement which permits/exempts that, he's believed

Concepts and Terms:

- נאָמָן One who is trustworthy with regards to tithing
- יוֶבֶּר One who is trustworthy and knowledgeable of the laws of purity

- One whose relative has died but not yet buried

ם יְּרוּמְה A mixture of תְּרוּמְה and חוּלִין

בין הַשְּׁמְשׁוֹת - Twilight, the period when it is uncertain whether it's day or night - when one declares that he's fulfilled all that he was commanded with regards to the tithes

- הַגְּבְּהָה - Acquiring an item by lifting it

יְצִיץ נְקוּב - A plant-pot with a hole at the bottom; this has the status of the ground

- אָרִיס One who rents and works a field in return for a percentage of the annual crop
- חוֹבֶר One who rents and works a field in return for a fixed amount of the annual crop
